## TUITION OFFICE ~ DO YOU KNOW?

FACTS will attempt three times to collect your tuition payment but only **once** for Incidental billing. If an incidental bill is missed, you must force pay that bill through FACTS directly or send payment to me at the rectory and I can receive it as a "paid at the institution" through FACTS for you. Secondly - FACTS puts your tuition payment into its payment queue 2 business days before it's due. Any adjustments must be done before that time. I am unable to make any adjustments to that bill after that.
