
OCTOBER MARIAN DEVOTIONS

TUITION: DO YOU KNOW?

Incidental billing will be billed 10 days before the due date. After School Care is "incidental billing". Each week your child's attendance will be entered for the days they attended ASCC. The invoice will be dated for the day they were entered, but the payment will be scheduled with the following month's tuition payment. As an example: Sept. 7-9th the invoice would be created on Sept. 12th, but the payment will not be due until the day of the month your October tuition payment will be made. If you have chosen to pay yearly for ASCC, your payments have been added to your tuition payments.
