INCIDENTAL BILLING

Here's how After School Care (ASCC) billing works:

email bss.pta@syrdiocese.org.

- ASCC charges are considered "incidental billing" and will be billed 10 days before they are due.
- We track your child's attendance weekly and create an invoice on the day their attendance is entered into the system.
- The invoice date might be in the current month (e.g., Sept. 9th for attendance between Sept. 5 and 6th), but the payment won't be due until your next month's tuition payment is scheduled.
- Yearly ASCC payments are already included in your tuition installments.
