



FACTS Grant & Aid Application

For the School Year Beginning Fall 2020

All families who are in need of Financial Assistance for the 2020-2021 school year, must complete The FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment application and submit it online by February 15, 2020. All applications are only submitted online. Financial Aid is made available for grades K-6. If you need assistance completing your application online please contact Mrs. Medina at 315-437-3394.

Information needed to complete your application:

- ✓ All applications must be submitted online only. To apply go to: online.factsmgt.com/aid
- ✓ Only 1 application per household. Please do not submit multiple applications. Supporting documentation as listed below, can be scanned and uploaded or faxed to FACTS at 1-866-315-9264. Our school ID code is **7871**.
- ✓ IRS Federal Income Tax Return, including all supporting schedules. If applicant and co-applicant file separately, we require both tax returns for the same tax year.
- ✓ Copies of all current W-2 Wage and Tax Statements for both the applicant and co-applicant. NOTE: If you are applying before you received all the 2019 W-2 Wage and Tax Statements, please submit them as soon as they become available.
- ✓ Copies of all supporting documentation for household Non-Taxable Income such as: Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- ✓ Payment of nonrefundable \$30 application fee.
